1. Nuclear bursts which occur in other European countries will be designated by the Sector operations centres in the countries concerned. Various types of designation are used, but in each case the designation is prefixed by the nationality letters as follows:

2. Bursts are identified by:

a. A serial number followed by a letter, where the number identifies a region or zone of the country and the letter indicates the burst designation, commencing with "A"; or

b. A four digit serial number where the first two figures identifies the region or zone of the country and the second two digits indicates the burst designation, commencing with "01"; or

c. A two digit serial number following the nationality letters, (used by some smaller countries), where the two digits indicates the burst designation, commencing with "01".
